Footpath Reinstatement Works on Denarau Island, Nadi

PURPOSE AND DESCRIPTION OF THE TENDER

The Energy Fiji Limited (EFL) is requesting proposal from Interested Contractors to carry out Footpath Reinstatement Works on Denarau Island, Nadi for Capital Project - Upgrade of Old Navakai Feeder from Nadi PS to Denarau SS - Scheme SR84/15.

Eligibility/Selection Criteria of the Bidding Contractor

The Contractor shall have a sound knowledge of the subject area. Contractor shall also be familiar with the contents of the “EFL Safety Manual” and strictly abide by it. The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions to prevent any damages to the EFL assets and private properties in the area.

The Bidder shall submit the names/contacts of utilities or projects where they have previously undertaken such work required by this Tender.

1. Contract Price

The Contractor shall submit the lump sum VIP price in Fijian currency to carry out the Reinstatement works [**Refer to Appendix 1 for Footpath Reinstatement Specifications**]. The Contractor shall submit his price for the Reinstatement of Footpath on Denarau Island after a site inspection with an EFL Representative.

2. Contractor Requirements

1. The Contractor shall be fully responsible for the **Supply of Materials, Machinery & Labour** for the Footpath Reinstatement works ensuring that it strictly abides by the required standards of Fiji Roads Authority (FRA).
2. EFL representative will be carrying out a joint site inspection with the Interested Bidders on **Tuesday 29/05/18 at 10.00am near the Main Denarau Bridge, Nadi** after which they can submit their Contract Price.
3. The Contractor shall be fully responsible to repair any damages done to access roads, driveways and other utilities services during the execution of the above work.
4. No royalty is payable by EFL to any party for the extraction of Aggregate.
5. It is the Contractors responsibility to ensure that they use Standard road signs & cones to control traffic and pedestrians. The working area shall be properly barricaded to ensure safety of their workers and the General public.

3. Registration & Other Information

The following information is required with the Tender Bid:

1. Registration details of the company.
2. Occupational Health & Safety Policy of the company.
3. Certificates and work experience of employees.
4. List of tools, equipment, machines and safety gears
5. Valid Tax Compliance Certificate
6. FNPF Compliance Certificate

The tender bid may not be considered if the above information is not attached with the Tender Bid.

The Contractor is to confirm in writing in their Tender Bid that they will submit the following information within five (5) days prior to the award of the contract:

1. Insurance cover for workers' health and safety.
2. Public liability cover.
3. Safety Management Plan

The award will be cancelled if the contractor is unable to provide the above information on time.

4. Contractor Personnel:

The Contractor shall only employ Licensed Machinery Operators and they shall be available on site as and when required by the EFL Representative in 24hours of the request.

6. Other Value Added Services

The bidder is open to include any other information that may add value to the services.

7. Tender Evaluation

After the bids are received, it will go through a normal Tender Evaluation Process as per EFL's Tender Policy and Procedures. The successful and unsuccessful bidders will be advised of the outcome after completion of the Tender Evaluation Process.

Appendix 1: Footpath Reinstatement Specifications

The Reinstatement of Footpath on Denarau Island has to meet the following requirements:

- The new slab is to match the thickness of the existing footpath slab
- Reinforced with 665 Steel Mesh
- Use concrete with a compressive strength of 20MPA
- Compact base layers with AP65 crushed granular material

Note: All reinstatement works shall strictly abide by the FRA Standards as stated in the “Code of Practice for Utility Operators”.

Subject Area: Main Denarau Bridge, Nadi

Note: Dimensions of area to be reinstated will be obtained by Contractors during the Site Inspection.

Submission of Tender

Two (2) hard copies of the tender bids in sealed envelope shall be deposited in the tender box located at the Supply Chain Office at the EFL Head Office, 2 Marlow Street, Suva, Fiji.

Courier charges for delivery of Tender Document must be paid by the bidders.

This tender closes at 4:00 p.m. (16.00hrs Fiji time) on Wednesday 6th June, 2018.

Each tender shall be sealed in an envelope with the envelope bearing only the following marking:
