1. Purpose and Description of the Computerised Maintenance Management System (CMMS)

The Energy Fiji Limited (EFL) invites proposals from reputable, qualified bidders for the implementation of a Computerised Maintenance Management System (CMMS).

The system should have all the features and functions for online e-Services and automation of current manual process flows.

2. Eligibility Criteria/Pre-qualification of the Bidder

The bidder should have proven experience and expertise in implementing and supporting maintenance management systems. The bidder must also demonstrate to have extensive experience with all aspects of their CMMS, including ongoing maintenance and support services.

3. Scope

At a very high level, the CMMS must have all the standard features of a Maintenance Management system, such as, but not limited to, the following:

- 9. Predictive Maintenance Management
- 10. Assessment and Renewal Planning
- 11. Materials Management
- 12. Compliance Management
- 13. GIS/GPS Interface
- 14. Document Management
- 15. Reporting/Business Intelligence
- 16. CMMS Dashboards
- 17. Browser agnostic web-based client interface

Bidders must also state if their solution has optional modules, if any, especially those that may be related to energy utilities. Bidders must provide reference sites (Energy Utilities) where their CMMS has been implemented.

The proposed system should also be able to integrate seamlessly to other EFL core systems such as Financial Management Information System (FMIS), HR/Payroll, and other EFL systems, where necessary.

4. Notes to Bidders

Short-listed Service Providers may be invited to present and discuss details of their proposals or even provide a trial as proof-of-concept.

Bidders should identify any work they are currently carrying out or competing for, which could cause a conflict of interest, and indicate how such a conflict would be avoided.

The Secretary Tender Committee will respond in writing if the question cannot be answered by directing the bidder to the appropriate section of the EOI. Copies of any written response may be made available to all parties that receive the EOI.
