INVITATION TO TENDER

The Energy Fiji Limited ("The Employer") invites sealed bids from suitable companies for the supply, packing and transporting (CFR) of "Digital Micro Ohm Meter."

All tenders for the contract shall be submitted on the appropriate forms provided and shall include the completed price schedule, technical schedule etc. The bid shall be based on a lump sum contract based on firm prices.

During evaluation of tenders, the Authority will invite a tenderer or tenderers for discussions, presentations and any necessary clarification before awarding of the contract.

The tender submissions close on Wednesday 28th August 2024 at 1600hrs (local) Fiji Time.

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1. INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDER

1. Scope of Bid

Energy Fiji Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the Employer"), wishes to receive bids for supply of Four (3) units of Digital Micro Ohm Meter sets with complete Accessories as specified in these bidding documents.

2. Qualification of the Bidder

To be qualified for award of Contract, bidders shall submit proposals regarding scheduling and resourcing, which shall be provided in sufficient detail to confirm the bidder's capability to fulfil the contract.

3. Cost of Bidding

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and the Employer will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs.

4. Deadline for Submission of Bids

Bids must be received by the Employer at the address specified above no later than 1600 hours (Fiji Time) (28th August 2024).

The Employer may at its discretion extend the deadline for submission of bids by issuing an addendum, in which case all rights and obligations of the Employer and the bidders previously subject to the original deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadlines extended.

5. Late Bids

Any bid received by the Employer after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed will be rejected and returned unopened to the bidder.

Employer's Right to accept any Bid and to reject any or all Bids The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders of the grounds for the Employer's action.

7. Notification of Award

Prior to expiration of the period of bid validity prescribed by the Employer, the Employer will notify the successful bidder by fax/email, confirmed by registered letter, that its bid has been accepted. This letter (hereinafter and in the Conditions of Contract called the "Letter of Acceptance") shall name the sum, which the Employer will pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution, completion and maintenance of the Works by the Contractor as prescribed by the Contract (hereinafter and in the Conditions of Contract called "the Contract Price").

The notification of award will constitute the formation of the Contract. Upon the furnishing by the successful bidder of a performance security, the Employer will promptly notify the other bidders that their bids have been unsuccessful.

8. Signing of Contract Agreement

At the same time that he notifies the successful bidder that its bid has been accepted, the Employer will send the bidder the Form of Contract Agreement provided in the bidding documents, incorporating all agreements between the parties.

Within 7 days of receipt of the Form of Agreement, the successful bidder shall sign the Form and return it to the Employer.

9. Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices

The Employer requires that the Contractor observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In Pursuance of this policy, the Employer:

- (a) defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:
 - (i) "corrupt practice" means behavior on the part of officials in the public or private sectors by which they improperly and unlawfully enrich themselves and/or those close to them, or induce others to do so, by misusing the position in which they are placed, and it includes the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of any such official in the procurement process or in contract execution; and
 - (ii) "fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract to the detriment of the Employer, and includes collusive practice among bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial noncompetitive levels and to deprive the Employer of the benefits of free and open competition;

2. TENDER SPECIFICATIONS

General Description

The preferred supply is to supply Energy Fiji Limited with the Digital Micro Ohmmeter. The Digital Micro Ohmmeter will be used to measure extremely low resistance and to test the integrity of electrical connection. The bidder's proposal shall address all functional and performance requirements with in the specification and shall include sufficient information and supporting documentation in order to determine compliance with this specification without further necessary inquiries.
